This year, our program will be virtual via Zoom, and we are looking for options to deliver certificates. This year, we are now offering a **sixth** category for **Science, Technology, Engineering, and Mathematics (STEM)**. We are asking for student winners from you in the category.

I am hoping you have already begun your selection process to identify students for the Youth Award. We will need a **list of winners completed by January 11th**, to prepare for the event. Also, we have example MLK Nominations Excel Sheet for you to send your winners to us by email via scanned PDF. Please be sure to include *First Name, Last Name, School, and Phone number* (if you want a phone reminder for them). Please write clearly and eligibly so we will have the correct spelling and information for our winners. No Fax entries are allowed.

We will accept your list of students as final winners, and we won't narrow the award from your selections. So, we ask you to notify your winners of the award program's date, time, and procedures. We have included an MLK Award Information Sheet that you can give each of your award winners once you have made your selections. We communicate the final instructions for the event by January 15th.

If you included the student's phone number, we would make a phone on Thursday, February 4th before the event to remind them about the program and to ask them to attend.

We are also encouraging students and their parents to attend the College Fair surrounding the program via Zoom. We will have several college representatives, and two sessions will be well worth their attendance. The College Fair is open to any student seeking information about colleges, not just the award recipients. Please encourage any interested students to attend that morning.

If a student cannot receive their award, we will send your certificates to your office by mail following the event. Corrections can be requested by returning the correction form included with this packet to your Guidance Counselor Office, or you can submit correction with a web page on our website.
